VSL	Vessel Load (when ocean container is created in Log-Net)
TRL	Trailer Load (when truck container is created in Log-Net; this will replace VSL)
CI	In Gate (container delivered to terminal)
LOD	Estimated Loaded to Vehicle (estimated date container loaded onto ship)
CAE	Carrier Vehicle Loaded (container loaded onto ship)
CVD	Vessel Departure (ship leaves port of departure)
CVA	Vessel Arrival (ship arrives at port of arrival)
CCR	Carrier Released (carrier receives payment and releases container for pick up)
DCH	Estimated Discharge from Vehicle (the estimated date of arrival at port)
CUV	Vehicle Unloaded (container unloaded from vessel)
ARR*	Arrival at the warehouse (container arrives at warehouse)
DVN*	Devanned (container unloaded and received in SAP)
DRP*	Drop Transload (used instead of DVN when certain items in container must be
	loaded into another container for continued shipping)
DRR*	Drop Arrival (used instead of DVN when other items receive DRP, those items
	whose movement ends at the location receive DRR instead)
MTY*	Empty returned (carrier contacted to pick up empty)
CRD	Empty Returned (carrier receives empty container)

Other events may appear for containers going to Ensenada.

XLD	Transloaded (shipments contained in an earlier container are now loaded in another. Containers originating from Mexico Staging will show this instead of VSL)
ITS*	Intrade Secure (assigned when container enters Intrade status, prevents unauthorized people from editing the container)
ICF*	Customs Inspection – No Problems (container is inspected by Customs, but has no issues)
ICI*	Customs Inspection – Incidents (container is inspected by Customs, but there are issues)
ITC*	Intrade Clear (assigned when Mexican Customs clears the container, and allows users to edit a container which previously was assigned the ITS event)
